THE INTERMEDIATE EDUCATION ACT, 1921

(UNITED PROVINCES ACT No. 11 OF 1921)

(Enacted by the U. P. Act No. V of 1941)
(Adopted and modified by the Government of India
(Adaptation of Indian Law) Order, 1937)

Received the assent of the Governor of the United Provinces
of Agra and Oudh on the 30th September, 1921, and of
the Governor-General on the 10th December, 1921, and
was published under section 51 of the Government of
India Act on the 7th January, 1922.

An Act for the establishment of a Board of High School
and Intermediate Education

WHEREAS it is expedient to establish a Board to
take the place of the Allahabad University in regulating
and supervising the system of High School and Inter-
mediate education in Uttar Pradesh, and to prescribe
therefor: It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be called the Intermediate
Education Act, 1921.

(2) It extends to the territories administered
by the Provincial Government of Uttar Pradesh.

(32) the High School Examination of the Rajputana University, Jaipur ;

(33) the Vidyadhikari Examination conducted by the Gangotri University, Rungri (Hardwar) provided it is not passed in compartments ;

(34) the Jadhav Examination conducted by the Jamia Millia Islamia, Delhi, provided the examination is not passed in compartments ;

(35) the Matriculation Examination of the East Punjab University ;

(36) the Matriculation Examination of the Gauhati University ;

(37) the Secondary School Certificate Examination conducted by the Secondary School Certificate Examination Board, Bombay ;

(38) the Higher Secondary Technical Certificate Examination (three year course) of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Delhi ;

(39) the Matriculation Examination of the University of Jammu and Kashmir, Srinagar.

(40) the High School Examination conducted by the Board of Secondary Education, Madhya Bharat, Gwalior, in 1951 and 1952.

3. No candidate shall be admitted to the Intermediate Examination unless two academic years shall have elapsed from the date of his or her passing the High School or an equivalent examination :
